Reserve Aid exists as a response to the hardships and grim financial realities experienced by the men and women of the United States Armed Forces Reserves.

Nearly one half of American troops serving in Iraq and Afghanistan are from Reserve units. As a result of lengthy activations, many Reservists are suffering emotionally and financially as they worry about providing for their families back home and completing their missions abroad.

Reserve Aid is a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization that makes unrestricted, need based grants to military Reservists, and families of Reservists, on full time deployment to a combat zone or homeland security position.

The Hardship of Service

- ★ 775,015 Reservists and National Guard members have been activated since 9/11/2001
- ★ 121,145 Reservists and National Guard are currently activated
- ★ 40% of the forces currently serving in Iraq/Afghanistan are Reservists or National Guard members
- ★ 23% of those returning have been denied re-employment
- ★ 43% of Reservists and National Guard members have been diagnosed with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) or other psychological problems
- ★ 773 Reservists and National Guard members have been killed in action.
- ★ Reserve Aid is currently assisting families of Reservists at the rate of approximately \$35,000 a month.

Reserve Aid does not make loans; our objective is to meet every valid emergency financial need of service members and their dependents within 48 hours of grant approval.
